
SUBJECT: Congressional Inquiry into Follow-Up Studies on Human Radiation Experimentation

TO: James S. Robertson, Director, Human Health & Assessments Div., Office of Health and Environmental Research, DOE, HQ, ER-73

Those experiments at Los Alamos National Laboratory in which human subjects participated in radiation studies were reviewed with D. F. Petersen of Los Alamos National Laboratory. These subjects were actually performing the studies at the time and voluntarily participated.

The records and publications written by the subjects describing the radiation experiments are stored in the Laboratory Archives and it would be feasible to search records for the names of the subjects; however, there is a possibility that some records may have been destroyed.
