DOCUMENTS AND DATA FILES
(Hard Copy and Magnetic Tape)

1. A draft document of manual of procedures followed in establishing the data files for the Oak Ridge population. This document was being prepared by Al Becker, and it and the related files were in his office at home at the time of his death.
2. All information coded from death certificates received since the summer of 1975. These data cover deaths for employees and controls from all plants. Two different records were coded in Oak Ridge for each death certificate. One record included general information from the death certificate, such as date of death, place of death, etc. The second record included only identifying information which was used for coding cause of death in Ohio. All these records were forwarded to Pittsburgh where the information was punched and put onto magnetic tape, but copies of these tapes were not forwarded to the computer center at Oak Ridge.
3. The 1976 or 1977 tape containing the information on the cause of death of Hanford employees and the approximately 600 additional death certificates used to update this tape.
4. All data supplied by the Social Security Administration to Dr. Mancuso in 1977 on death occurring in the Hanford population since 1973. If any death certificates were obtained, these also should be included.

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5. Approximately 100 magnetic tapes, copied from tapes at Oak Ridge that have been sent to Pittsburgh and have not been returned.
This includes tapes with information on Mallinckrodt and National Lead that were sent to Pittsburgh.
6. All data shipped directly from Mound Laboratory to Pittsburgh.
