[REDACTED], about 37 years old, fell 50 feet to his death while working on the pilot plant addition at the Grand Forks Energy Research Center (GFERC). The accident occurred at about 1:30 p.m., CDT, July 6, 1978. There were no witnesses. Grand Forks Police are at the scene.

[REDACTED] was employed by Fargo Foundry Western Steel Products, subcontractor to Harpster Construction Company, the prime contractor.
