MEMORANDUM to Colonel James E. Lempert, C.E., Manhattan Project, P. O. Box 2610, Washington 25, D. C.

1. A teletype was received from Senator Claude Pepper, addressed to Colonel Stafford L. Warren and dated 27 June 1946. This message requested of Colonel Warren a statement of his opinion concerning Senate Bill 1875. This Bill relates to a proposed \$100,000,000. expenditure for research on cancer. Permission was asked to place in the Senate Record a transcript of Colonel Warren's statement on the subject of cancer which he made before the House Committee.

2. At the request of Colonel Marsden, a teletype answer was prepared to Senator Pepper in which it was stated that his message would be forwarded to Colonel Warren at Bikini. Also, this office contacted the Area Engineer at Berkeley and Captain Bednarzyk of our Berkeley office. Senator Pepper's teletype was transmitted by telephone. The above permission was requested and notification to this office of the action taken by Colonel Warren was asked for.
