MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN THE ATOMIC ENERGY COMMISSION AND THE AIR FORCE MISSILE TEST CENTER

11/28/52

WHEREAS, buildings and structures have been constructed at the Air Force Missile Test Center, Patrick Air Force Base, Cocoa, Florida, (Hereinafter referred to as "Cocoa") with funds of the Atomic Energy Commission (hereinafter referred to as the "AEC") in connection with the development and engineering tests of the Guided Missile War Head Program and

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WHEREAS, it was contemplated that a written agreement between the Manager, Santa Fe Operations Office, AEC, and Cocoa would be prepared with respect to the interests, rights and duties of the parties concerning such buildings and structures;

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NOW, THEREFORE, it is agreed as follows:

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1. a. The AEC will have exclusive use and occupancy of the assembly building and the appurtenant structures (hereinafter referred to as the "buildings") which have been constructed with AEC funds at Cocoa until the Field Manager, Sandia Field Office, AEC, notifies Cocoa that the AEC is withdrawing from the AEC Guided Missile War Head Program. Upon such notification the buildings will come under the jurisdiction and control of Cocoa. Space in the buildings may be made available to the Armed Forces Special Weapons Project (hereinafter referred to as "AFSWP") on a temporary basis but only with the prior approval of the Field Manager, Sandia Field Office, AEC. AFSWP shall vacate such space upon the request of the Field Manager, Sandia Field Office, AEC, when in his opinion the space is needed by the AEC in connection with its program.

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
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- b. During the time the AEC has exclusive use and occupancy of the buildings, no additions or alterations will be made to the buildings by Cocoa without the prior approval of the Field Manager, Sandia Field Office, AEC.
 - c. Equipment purchased with AEC funds and placed in the buildings will remain the property of the AEC and will be replaced, removed, or disposed of as the AEC may deem advisable. All such equipment will be marked with AEC identification and property numbers.
 - d. Utilities including water, gas or other fuel, and electricity for use in the buildings will be furnished to the AEC without charge by Cocoa.
 - e. Communications facilities including telephone lines, TWX lines and telephone instruments will be furnished by Cocoa. TWX instruments will be installed by the local telephone company as requested by and at the expense of the AEC or its contractor. Long distance toll charges shall be billed monthly to Sandia Field Office, AEC, on Form 1080.
2. Fire protection and maintenance of the buildings, utilities, and communications facilities will be furnished to the AEC without charge by Cocoa.

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3. Security guards for guarding the buildings will be furnished in accordance with the agreement between the Field Manager, Sandia Field Office, AEC, and the Commanding General, Air Force Missile Test Center, Patrick Air Force Base, Cocoa, Florida, signed on July 25, 1951 and July 30, 1951 respectively.
