The reference states in part:

"In anticipation of a requirement to brief the 238 Committee (National Security Council) on this (subject) program, and in order to be able to present a well coordinated ABC package, I would like a tri-laboratory group to be convened at an early date and to review the LRL, LASL and SC R/V warhead hardening program in order to consolidate requirements to the maximum extent thereby minimizing funds required."

Such a meeting of LASL, LRL, AFWL, and Sandia has been scheduled for 31 July. I have asked Charlie Winter, 9130, to coordinate our preparations for this meeting. I envision that this meeting will define a joint LASL, LRL, SC, AFWL program and that differences in approach will be coordinated.

The Sandia effort for this program is quite diverse and covers many areas. I would like to have each of the groups involved in this program outline their effort in draft form so that these drafts can be compiled into a single document by 9130. The following organizations are, therefore, requested to provide their inputs to 9130 by the close of business 23 July: 1420, 1530, 1540, 5320, 5410, 7250, 7420, 7430, 8120, 8140.

Each organization's draft should cover the following:

1. Test plan for 1964 nuclear test.
2. Reasons for conducting the experiment.
3. Nonnuclear tests required in preparation for the nuclear test and their reasons.

5. Schedule of activities.

Some of the organizations may find it useful to combine their inputs. Similarly, 8120 and 8140, for instance, may find that their inputs have already been covered in the LRL summary so that no new write-up is required.
