Reference 1 authorizes Sandia Corporation to participate in the performance of a joint firing-test program with the Army for the W48-0/XM454, on all New Material System Test (NMST) and Stockpile Sampling Program (SSP) samples. Reference 2 is a proposal for performance of these programs. Reference 3 is an amendment to Reference 2. These tests will be conducted with nonnuclear and non-HE test vehicles containing certain components from the selected weapon samples, and radiation type telemetry. The telemetry to be used in these special test vehicles will satisfy the monitoring requirements for both Sandia Corporation and Picatinny Arsenal.
