Mr. James M. Miller:


Returned herewith is the 1953/54 agreement between the City and County of San Francisco and the University of use of areas at Laguna Honda Home. I question Mr. Calkins' statement, "Actually the form is generally satisfactory, but see par. 3(b) which casts a possible heavy burden on us—broader than in earlier agreements." This paragraph agrees exactly with par. 8(b) of the 1952/53 agreement.

Also, I don't understand his question, "Could we secure a policy in this instance which would run over our present limits?" Where do we go from here?
