Enclosed is an application from Dr. B. V. A. Low-Beer of the Department of Radiology for a supplemental grant for five months' interim support of the project "The Use of K^{42} as an Indicator for the Localization of Deep-Seated Tumors", in the amount of \$931.65 for the period 1 February 1954 through 30 June 1954.

The original application (SGA 101) was sent to you on 14 December 1953, for forwarding to the California Division of the American Cancer Society for consideration by the Special Grants Committee. Owing to unexpected delays, the American Cancer Society will not be able to make funds available before 1 July 1954, rather than the January 1 date requested. Therefore, it has been suggested that we submit supplemental applications for interim support. The Cancer Board has advanced \$3,800 to Dr. Low-Beer and this money will be refunded to Cancer Board if the American Cancer Society approves his supplemental grant request.

Adequate space and facilities are available exactly as indicated on the worksheet recently submitted.
