Attached are four copies of an application to the American Cancer Society, Inc. forwarded by Dr. William N. Valentine of the Department of Medicine, School of Medicine, Los Angeles, requesting \$27,625 for the period July 1, 1957 to June 30, 1958, and/or \$48,675 for the period July 1, 1957 to June 30, 1959 in support of the research program entitled "Studies of Leukocyte Physiology in the Normal, in Leukemia, and in Other Hematological Disorders" under the direction of Dr. Charles G. Craddock of the Department. After the required approvals and signature of the President, the two copies should be forwarded to the American Cancer Society, Inc., 521 West 57th Street, New York 19, New York, so as to reach its destination as near January 1, 1957 as possible. There are additional file copies.

Dr. Valentine has indicated in his letter of November 30, 1956 attached that leukemia and other disorders of the white blood cells in the human body are thought to be due to a disturbance of the normal growth processes of these cells. The purpose of this study will be to investigate the basic processes involved, particularly regarding the bone marrow, so that a more precise approach may be made in the treatment of leukemia and related diseases.

We have been further informed that space is available at the Veterans Administration Center as well as approximately 350 square feet of space in the Medical Center and no other activity will be displaced nor will there be other than normal use of utilities.

The budget seems adequate and is satisfactory to the Business Office. Provision for participating in the State Employees' Retirement System has been deleted due to the fact that it is contrary to University policy to request reimbursement of such expenditures of non-Federal government agencies. However, provision has been made for the allowable overhead of the American Cancer Society, Inc., 15% of the research funds requested.

We have been further informed that nothing of a hazardous nature is involved; however, if hazards should arise, all necessary precautions will be taken to avoid damage to property or injury to personnel.

If the application has your approval, it will be appreciated if you will so indicate in the space provided, forward it for the additional approvals, signature of the President, and submission to its destination which it should reach as near January 1, 1957 as possible.
