Enclosed herewith please find copies of correspondence received from Paul L. Wermer, M.D., Secretary, Committee on Research of the Council on Pharmacy and Chemistry of the American Medical Association, relative to the above mentioned grant request made under date of December 28, 1953 by James A. Halsted, M.D., Associate Clinical Professor of Medicine, in the amount of \$690.00. The purpose of this request was to facilitate the purchase of equipment needed to carry out the study of the absorption of vitamin B₁₂ in man as measured by fecal excretion of cobalt⁶⁰-labeled vitamin B₁₂. As indicated by Dr. Wermer, this grant will be known as a William Volker Grant No.15. Approval of the administrative officers of the University was given under date of January 29, 1954.

According to the regulations of the American Medical Association, it will be necessary for the treasurer of the University to forward a statement over his signature to the effect that on completion of the above mentioned study an accounting of expenditures will be rendered, and any unexpended funds returned to the American Medical Association. After receipt of such a statement, a check for the full amount of the grant will be sent to the treasurer.
