Dear Dean Smyth:

Enclosed is a revised budget for the project "Clinical Cancer Research with Emphasis on Experimental Therapy and Patho-Physiology (Chemotherapy of lung cancer, leukemia and malignant lymphoma; and hormonal-surgical treatment of mammary cancer)", in the amount of \$75,000 for the period 1 September 1954 through 31 August 1955.

In a letter dated March 31, 1954 Dr. C. Donald Larsen, Assistant Chief of the Research Grants and Fellowships Branch, National Cancer Institute, informed me that the National Advisory Cancer Council had recommended approval of our application for three research grants in a total amount of \$75,000 for the above period. He requested that we submit a revised budget, in a combined application if we preferred. Accordingly, we are submitting this revised budget for the projects formerly identified as follows:-

"Clinical Cancer Research with Emphasis on Experimental Therapy and Patho-Physiology" (C-2085C)	\$37,003.00
"Chemotherapy and Patho-Physiology in Lung Cancer" (C-2365)	26,158.51
"Chemotherapy and Patho-Physiology in Leukemia and Lymphoma" (C-2364)	12,548.66

These three applications were forwarded to the U.S. Public Health Service by the Office of the President on February 5 and 15, 1954. There is no alteration in the enclosed revised combined budget, except for reduction in the amount requested, and omission of certain items.

Dear Dr. Meader:

In reply to Dr. Larsen's letter of notification, March 31, 1954, we are pleased to note the March 23rd recommendation of approval of the three research grant applications indicated above, in a total amount of \$75,000 for the period September 1, 1954 to August 31, 1955, and support for the following year in the same amount.

In accordance with the suggestion from the Council, we have chosen to submit a combined budget for the three projects, rather than three separate revised budgets. Although the renewal grant application C-2085 (C) has to do chiefly with hormonal influences in breast cancer, rather than chemotherapy of leukemia and allied neoplastic diseases, I have been assured by Dr. Larsen that it would be appropriate to include provision for this study in the single combined budget.

We are glad to learn that the Surgeon General has agreed to accept the Council's recommendation that the award be made provided the necessary funds are appropriated for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1954.

The research work to be carried out by the award will be essentially that set forth in the three applications. Other sources will be sought for major support of clinical research beds which constituted a large item in each of the applications. Fortunately, some such funds have already become available for the fiscal year 1954-55, beginning July 1, and we anticipate that they will increase in subsequent years, so that it will not be necessary to request the degree of clinical bed support indicated in our original applications.

In view of the fact that we have chosen to submit a single combined budget, the following is suggested as a new title:

"Clinical Cancer Research with emphasis on experimental therapy and patho-physiology (chemotherapy of lung cancer, leukemia and lymphoma; and hormonal-surgical treatment of mammary cancer)"

The principal investigators will be David A. Wood, M.D., Seymour M. Farber, M.D., Nicholas L. Petrakis, M.D., and Maurice Galante, M.D. Other investigators participating in the project will be those listed in the three applications, - H. Glenn Bell, M.D., William C. Deamer, M.D., B. V. A. Low-Beer, M.D., and Peter Forsham, M.D.

The conditions set forth in the memorandum of February 1, 1954\* pertaining to the award of Cancer Chemotherapy Research Grants are herewith accepted, inasmuch as it is our desire to participate in the cooperative research effort of the National Cancer Institute in chemotherapy, and in view of the fact that much of our project falls within the scope of this activity. It is my understanding in conversation with Dr. C. Donald Larsen, Assistant Chief, and in his correspondence of March 31st, that inclusion of the breast cancer component in the single combined budget is not only proper in this regard but in keeping with the action of the Council. In actuality, a major part of the research work to be supported by the combined budget will pertain to chemotherapy.

Major emphasis will be placed for the present on chemotherapy of leukemia and allied neoplastic disease. Apportionment of the \$75,000 grant for the fiscal year 1954-55 to the three areas is indicated as follows (see Exhibit A for detail):-

1) Chemotherapy and Patho-physiology in Lung Cancer	\$21,643.00
2) Chemotherapy and Patho-physiology in Leukemia and Malignant Lymphoma	21,276.80
3) Hormonal-Surgical Studies in Breast Cancer	22,850.00
Sub-total	\$65,769.00
General Assistance	1,840.95

Retirement Contributions	1,234.49
8% Institutional Overhead	5,555.56
Total	\$75,000.00

As indicated earlier the University of California is interested in participating in studies proposed by the Committee of Cancer Chemotherapy Investigators, and notes that it will have representation thereon.
