MEMORANDUM TO MR. CORLEY:

The attached renewal of Dr. Nello Pace's contract for research on the Function of the Liver in Carbon Monoxide Metabolism has been reviewed by Mr. Calkins per his comments of March 7.

The Project Director has submitted a reply to Mr. Calkins' remarks, and I agree with him that this work is similar to that previously done, and in fact, does not involve any more hazardous work to the subjects than occurs, for example, under the Prosthetics Devices contract.

All subjects are paid for their time and efforts and will receive reimbursement under the State compensation laws. The medical phase of the work is directly supervised by Dr. Warren of the U. C. Medical Staff and, I believe we are amply protected by our blanket malpractice insurance.

If you believe Dr. Pace's response to Mr. Calkins is satisfactory, will you please return it to the latter with your recommendation.
