Dear Chancellor Allen:

- Several months ago, Mr. Stull made a request for information concerning U.C.L.A. Medical School activities in affiliated institutions. (See appended copy of Mr. Stull's letter.)
- The following reply has been prepared:

Education and Research Programs in Affiliated Institutions.
The U.C.L.A. School of Medicine and its faculty carry on certain educational and research programs in the Los Angeles Veterans' Administration Center, the Long Beach Veterans' Administration Hospital, the Los Angeles County General Hospital, Harbor County General Hospital, the Olive View Sanatorium, the San Fernando Veterans Administration Hospital, the Institut de Recherches Medicales de l'Oceanie Francaise, Papeete, Tahiti, the Cedars of Lebanon Hospital, the St. John's Hospital and the Metropolitan State Hospital. The educational and investigational environments of these institutions, as they are concerned in these programs, are controlled by the U.C.L.A. School of Medicine by its appointment of faculty and research personnel concerned with these programs. Responsibility for the appropriate conduct of these teaching and research endeavors is on the departmental level, and is in accordance with University regulations controlling such endeavors. Responsibility for patient care resides in the duly constituted authorities of the various institutions, and faculty members participate in such patient care as staff members of these institutions. The School is not, and should not be responsible for patient care in these institutions.

- This reply is sent to you with the request that you forward it to Mr. Stull or Mr. Corley, or make other disposition of it as you may see fit.
