MEMORANDUM

TO : Public Relations Officer or other Person Designated to receive Information on Public Health Service Research Grants

FROM : Chief, Division of Research Grants
National Institutes of Health

SUBJECT: Notice and Transmittal of Information concerning Public Health Service Research Grant Awards

As a result of discussions with a large number of deans and public relations officers, the National Institutes of Health has ascertained that local grantee institutions prefer to accept responsibility for any publicity to be given on any individual Public Health Service research grant. In order to furnish information on the grants being awarded to an institution, the Division of Research Grants, following the June 1954 series of National Advisory Council meetings, mailed to each grantee-institution carbon copies of the formal award statements furnished to investigators as notice that their applications for research grant support have been approved for payment. At that time, it was felt that copies of these Statements of Research Grant Award would be the most expeditious method of advising Public Relations Offices of the grants being made in their institutions.

Our experience in the past few months has indicated that the system of mailing to you large numbers of individual Statements of Research Grant Award is an unwieldy procedure, for both the local grantee institutions and the Public Health Service. We have therefore determined that a more convenient method for providing notice of grants being awarded is to furnish to each institution that portion of our regular Public Health Service report which deals with that particular institution. Sufficient data are incorporated in this report to help responsible offices determine whether follow-up with the principal investigator is indicated. Whether or not a statement would be issued to the press and how any such statement would be prepared would then be local decisions.

We have just completed a report listing the research grants recommended for payment by the National Advisory Councils at their last series of meetings. The portion of the report dealing with your institution is attached. Unless you advise us to the contrary, we shall continue mailing this type of information to you after the Council meetings in February, June, and October of each year.
