Dear Dr. Lawrence:

During 1960 - 61 a major U. S. scientific exhibit will be presented in Argentina, Brazil, Venezuela and Peru. The exhibit is to include technical facilities and equipment necessary to illustrate radioisotope applications in industry, agriculture, and medicine. In addition, a low power operating reactor and a 2,000 curie, Cobalt-60 gamma facility will provide the local scientific community with an opportunity to train and perform actual research. An estimated four million people will see this exhibition of which many will actually work and participate in technical symposia and meetings.

Your cooperation and assistance in providing information and photographs for use in the U. S. Atomic Energy Commission's exhibit program in Latin America is greatly appreciated.
