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Discussed with Dr. Robertson, the Chairman of the CIRC Committee, the radiation dose received by patients having neutron activation and whole body counting.

The radiation dose measurements were made in a phantom. The dose is maintained the same by altering factors such as time, depending on the size, weight, etc. of the patient.

It is hardly practical to measure each individual dose at the time of the exposure.
