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The Medical Emergency Plans Committee was inactive throughout most of the past year due, in part, to the recent revision of the Major Emergency Medical Plan in the summer of 1973 and, in part, to the preoccupation of the Committee chairman.

At a meeting of the Committee on August 1, 1973, last year's actions and the revised emergency plans were reviewed by the past chairman, Dr. R.A. Conard. A recommendation to the Medical Staff, subsequently presented by the chairman at a Staff meeting, was that the Industrial Medicine service be urged to review medical emergency handling for the entire Department staff from time to time as part of the staff seminar program, and that a copy of the local emergency plan be included in the "indoctrination kit" provided to new staff members.

Reports of Hospital Fire Drills on October 8, 1973 and January 30, 1974 were received by the Committee.

On October 30, 1973, the Committee's chairman participated in an Emergency Planning Meeting with Suffolk County officials, hosted by the Laboratory. He presented highlights of Medical Department and Hospital participation in the Laboratory's Major Emergency Plan and also noted the Hospital's local emergency plan. There were presentations and discussions of various BNL emergency and accident plans and of Police and Fire Group capabilities and procedures. Ambulance and fire-truck availability in the County and the role of the Department of Health's Emergency Medical Coordinator were reviewed. BNL participation in monthly meetings of the County Medical Emergency Group was solicited.
