 SUBJECT: MONTHLY NARRATIVE REPORT

DATE: June 30, 1948

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1. Insurance Section denied reimbursability of certain insurance and workmen's compensation payments made by C. C. Moore & Co., cost-plus sub-subcontractor of General Electric Company.
2. A procedure was adopted and placed in effect for the investigation of accidents involving AEC personnel operating Government vehicles and an Investigating Board established in connection therewith to recommend disciplinary action where such is warranted.
3. A radiation injury claim reached this office wherein complainant was a former AEC employee stationed on this project. Claimant is one _____, employed from December 1944 to February 1947. The Division of Biology and Medicine and the Insurance Section, Washington, D. C. were notified.
4. One other alleged radiation injury claim reached this office in June, involving former GE employee.
5. Preliminary negotiations were begun to provide suitable insurance coverage for the newly begun classified work performed under GE subcontract with the National Carbon Co., at Morganton, N. C.
6. A detailed insurance underwriting study of the project work was begun by the Insurance Section. Completion expected by 7/15/48.
7. Investigative work was begun by the Insurance Section with respect to common law suit for \$25,619.50 alleging negligence of GE Plaintiff, one _____. This action demands close supervision by this office since the injury complained of arose within a restricted area and plaintiff was engaged in highly classified work.
8. Total workmens compensation awards and payments during month of June. These payments made to the State Department of Labor and Industries reimbursing the Department for disbursements during May, 1948: \$5,685.46.
9. Public Liability payments during June, 1948: none. (No billings received from insurance carrier).
10. Workmens compensation injuries reported to the State Department of Labor and Industries, June 1948: 97. ... *Richard's office*

A proposed procedure was developed and submitted for the Manager's consideration for the establishment of an Occupational Disease Claims Advisory Committee to safeguard security in the event litigation is brought or seems likely to be brought as result of alleged special hazard injury. This procedure also recommended certain procedures dealing with consultants, contract medical institutions, etc., for examination of claimants.

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
