Dear Dr. Brucer:

This concerns your letter of January 25, 1956 to Dr. Dunham. At the suggestion of Dr. Bruess, we contacted Dr. Matthew Block of Denver. His reply is quoted in part:

"Dr. Wasson was then (1928) a member of the Child Research Council of the University. There were about 40 children in the original group. One has died of tuberculosis and one is a suicide. 30 are being followed and all are in good health. Between the age of 1 month and 5 years they each received a total of 0.3r. Another 186 have been followed with long bone films and they also are healthy.
