This will confirm the memorandum dated February 12, 1953 from Mr. R. L. Faulkner to you on the above subject. It is my intention to attempt to visit the mills at Durango, Monticello, Uravan, Naturita, Grand Junction and Rifle during the period of April 1 through April 10, 1953.

I have contacted Dr. T. W. Hale of the Union Carbide and Carbon Corporation in New York for his assistance in arranging visits to Uravan and Rifle.

I expect to be driving from Las Vegas, Nevada, and should like to visit the plants in the order named by car. I realize that the weather conditions on the Plateau may make it difficult to accomplish this mission at this time of the year. However, because of my being in Las Vegas at the time, it would be very desirable if this could be accomplished.
