Dear Dr. Weiss:

Thank you for your letter of April 18, 1956. As requested, we are returning one of the pandanus samples numbered 790 as well as a pandanus sample numbered 588, which is still unaccounted for. Also, we are returning the soil sample number 655 complete. I believe this straightens out all inconsistencies in sample numbering.

At the present time our results will be expressed in terms of d/m/gm or kg of material as received at HASL. If you could send us the wet weights obtained at the time of collection, I am sure that this would make for more accurate interlaboratory comparisons.
