

Oct. 15 Fink called Langham about 4:00 p.m. to tell him that first human injection of product was to be made 10/16/45 about noon. Langham planned to run a spectrophotometric curve on his sample of our stock solin and call before injection time if solin had changed from its +4 valence state. Fink reported that our rats appeared to have about 2% to 3% of the dose in their livers at 4 days (theirs usually was 6%)

Phone call to Dr. Langham at Santa Fe at 12:30 p.m. 11/16/45.

The following points were discussed: The matter of decreasing the protein and mineral and fluid intake of diets of subsequent patients so that the urine specimens will be of smaller volume and more readily prepared for analysis. It was agreed that no further acid of any kind would be added to urine specimens. We will continue to add formalin, however, to urine samples. No preservative is to be added to the blood and the anti-coagulant will still be sodium citrate. It is my understanding that Dr. Langham would let us proceed with the experiments on the 3rd. Subject, Daigneault, but I had difficulty in understanding him and we are waiting for written confirmation on this point.

Jan 9, 1946 11:45 a.m. Langham called Fink from Santa Fe to ask when the dummy injection solution were sent (answer 1/3/45). I reported that conditions are much improved and he thinks we might as well go ahead as scheduled. He promised to send data on 1st 3 or 4 patients in a day or two.
