

The reference to the project, "Translocation of Yellowcake from the Human Respiratory Tract", P30400, HSC 78-2, and related correspondence, it appears that the required number of urine samples may be available from personnel of licensee operators that have a bioassay program. However, the situation is marginal as more licensee operators than anticipated operate without a bioassay program.

Should it be necessary to ask a small number of employees (through the licensee) to submit urine samples for research purposes, please advise what constraints and/or actions the HSC would consider as appropriate other than informed consent as to the number and purpose of the samples. The identity of individuals contributing urine samples continues to be outside the scope of the project.

Guidance is being sought in advance to avoid any possibility of needing last minute crash-type actions.
