Transmitted herewith are copies of two letters from J. E. Lutz and Company and a memorandum from Dr. Holland pertaining to malpractice, workmen's compensation, and comprehensive liability coverage in connection with the Cancer Research Hospital being operated by the Oak Ridge Institute of Nuclear Studies.

We understand that under the rates indicated in the letter of December 16, 1949, the cost of the hospital malpractice insurance would be \$1500, doctors \$800, nurses \$225, other members of the staff \$40, and premises coverage \$100, making a minimum total of \$2665. The number of internes and graduate students are not presently indicated.

In the absence of the Institute's business manager, Mr. J. W. Mumford, the writer was advised by Mr. H. D. Beck of that organization that one bed is now in operation at the hospital; that the insurance binder was effective as of May 1, 1950, and provides coverage until the policies are issued; and that there is no way of comparing rates on the malpractice insurance because of the unique nature of the operation. He further stated that the engineer mentioned in the letter of December 16 had been there on a routine trip, conferred with Dr. Pollard and Mr. Mumford, and asked a number of questions on safety and radiation for the purpose of evaluating the risk.

We would like you to review the letters and give us your comments on them.
