Murphy June 17 gave Asahi correspondent Suzukawa interview for attribution "American official". Following are main points by Murphy in answer questions:

1/ Specific US plans re Pacific Security Organization have not (repeat not) been formulated. Present possibility Japan would be invited participate "remote".

2/ US has received no (repeat no) Japanese proposal for formal consultation re Japanese economic situation. Subject discussed Mukai and others. US of course concerned and desires be helpful.

3/ US officials fully understand reasons Yoshida trip postponed and desire see Yoshida when he can come.

4/ Diet disturbance not necessarily reflection on Japanese parliamentary Government but merely single incident of type which occurs elsewhere.

5/ US closely following condition injured fishermen and have agreed in principle make compensation despite concern over lack of firsthand information on injuries sustained.

6/ No significant change US view re war criminals and Ryukyus and Bonins.

Would appreciate report any Asahi reaction this interview.
