Naval Radiological Defense Laboratory to the Chief, Armed Forces Special Weapons Project, dated 3 June 1954, File 3-931B, Subject: "USNRDL Preliminary Report on Water Sampling, Operation CASTLE, Shots Yankee and Nectar," with 6 inclosures, Secret, Copy 2, which was delivered to you by Dr. Scoville of this headquarters on 10 June 1954. The data in this letter were obtained as a part of Project 2.7 of the Military Effects Program of Operation CASTLE by the Scripps Institute of Oceanography and the U. S. Naval Radiological Defense Laboratory. These data were forwarded to your office at this time in order to assist you in interpreting measurements which were obtained by means of aircraft surveys by the New York Operations Office. It is desired to emphasize that these results are extremely preliminary in nature and should be used with caution until further analyses and oceanographic correlations are completed. A preliminary report of this project is now in preparation and should be available shortly. Complete analysis of the data will probably not be available for several months.

Since the aircraft surveys which were conducted by the New York Operations Office would be of considerable value in the analysis of the data of Project 2.7, it would be appreciated if you could arrange to have the results of these surveys forwarded to Dr. Roger Revelle, Scripps Institute of Oceanography and the


