SUBJECT: Use of Volunteers in Research


TO: Commanding Generals

1. Reference is made to letter, AGAM-P (H) 702.3 (4 Mar 57) CMLWS, Headquarters, Department of the Army, 18 April 1957, subject as above.

2. Paragraph 7 of referenced letter is changed to read as follows:

"7. On the first day of each month the ZI Army commander, designated to furnish volunteers for the following month, will furnish the Commanding Officer, US Army Chemical Warfare Laboratories, Army Chemical Center, Maryland, the name, grade, ASN, organization and station of at least 30 volunteers. The Commanding Officer, Army Chemical Center, Maryland will furnish the ZI Army commander with a fund citation for the number of volunteers to be furnished. The ZI Army commander will issue the necessary orders. Posters, literature, and further information to aid in recruiting volunteers will be furnished by the Army Chemical Center, upon request."
