As requested in the letter sent to the Public Affairs Office, Fitzsimons Army Medical Center from the Department of Defense Radiation Experiments Command Center, I am forwarding copies of six reports of food irradiation experiments conducted by the U.S. Army Medical Nutrition Laboratory at Fitzsimons Army Hospital between 1956 and 1959. These reports were all that could be found related to studies of the feeding of irradiated food to human subjects conducted by the Nutrition Laboratory during that time. It should be emphasized that feeding of irradiated food to human subjects does not in any way expose those subjects to radiation. These studies should not be confused with research in which human subjects were exposed to radioactive material or ionizing radiation.
