SUBJECT: Records and Radiation Testing

1. Reference message, HQDA, DACS-ZA, 151600Z Feb 94, SAB.
2. Requested information Part I for the U.S. Army Test and Evaluation Command (TECOM) is as follows:

a. Identify organization that might have conducted or sponsored human radiation experiments.


