25. (U) Progress: Jul 68 thru Aug 69. Under the conditions of this study, WR-638 appeared to be relatively non-toxic although in high doses (>10 gm/day) causing a high incidence of G-1 complaints and one instance of dermatitis. The drug was fairly well accepted by the subjects except at the higher doses when the number of tablets at each dose was excessive and may have been a limiting factor on this basis alone.
