RADIOISOTOPE COMMITTEE

20 July 1965

1. Pursuant to the provisions of Hospital Regulation 15-1 dated 27 October 1964, a quarterly meeting of the Radioisotope Committee was convened on 20 July 1965, in the Office of the Chief, Radiology Service, at 1330 hours. Colonel Orbison, Chief, Department of Medicine, President of the Radioisotope Committee, acted as chairman and CWO-3 King as recorder.

2. The following members were present:

3. The minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

4. Under old business, Colonel Orbison informed the committee that the application for By-Product Material License Renewal had been acted upon and license was extended to 31 May 1967.

5. Major Preston advised that he would be departing this command during August 1965. Major Ronald D. Moore, MC, attended the meeting as an observer. He will replace Major Preston as Chief, Radioisotope Section, Radiology Service, and become a member of the Radioisotope Committee.

6. The report of the Radiation Protection Officer was received and no discrepancies were noted either in receipt, storage, handling or disposal of radioisotopes and there were no deviations from procedures during the reporting period.

7. The report of the Chief, Radioisotope Clinic was received and no discrepancies in the Radioisotope Clinic existed nor were there any deviations in the administration of the radioisotopes. Major Preston also presented the report covering quantities of radioisotopes procured, used, disposed of and in storage at the end of the period (1 April 1965 through 30 June 1965).




