1. This report confirms FONCON report, 1500 hours, 12 May 1965, between Captain Louis B. Levy of the Medical Field Service School, Fort Sam Houston, Texas, and Mr. Alphas L. Jones, this Agency.

2. The two specimens submitted were identified as 24-hour collections from Major Keith L. Riley on 30-31 March 1965 and 5-6 April 1965. The specimens had volumes of 2000 and 675 mls, respectively. The specimens were assayed in accordance with recognized bioassay procedures and contained no detectable plutonium or uranium.

3. Since the two analyses indicated no detectable amounts of plutonium and uranium, it is the opinion of this Agency that the individual from whom the specimens were obtained did not accumulate a body burden of plutonium or uranium.
