1. This exposure was incurred during participation in the clean up operations at the SL-1 reactor site, National Reactor Testing Station, Idaho.

2. Participation by Chemical Corps personnel was fully coordinated with the Surgeon General and the Atomic Energy Commission by the Chief Safety Office, OCCALO.

3. The Army Chemical Center film badge was worn in addition to personnel monitoring devices provided at the site.

4. The exposure was planned and controlled by Health Physicists at NRTS and was not received in connection with work performed under any AEC license for the Army Chemical Center.
