
1. Our photodosimetry records pertaining to the radiation exposure of SP5 Robert W. Rogerson reveal the following information:

- a. USARECSTA, Fort Jackson, South Carolina, January 1962 to March 1962: Name of subject individual does not appear on our records.
 - b. USAAMSC, Fort Sill, Oklahoma: Service for this installation was transferred to Sacramento Army Depot, Sacramento, California in September 1960.
 - c. USASESCS, Fort Gordon, Georgia, 28 October 1962 through 24 November 1962: Dose received .008 rem. 25 November 1962 through 19 January 1963: Dose received - zero.
- SP5 Rogerson's name not listed after this date.
- d. HHC SP Trps, Fort Monmouth, New Jersey: Record for this period not available.
 - e. Yuma Test Station, Yuma, Arizona: Film badge service for this installation was cancelled in 1960.
 - f. RUAMJC, Camp Carroll Depot, Waegwan, Korea is not serviced by this depot since it is in the Sacramento Mission area.
