I have just received a report regarding the recent radiological tests at Dugway. The Air Weather Service personnel at Dugway did a very adequate job in their observing and forecasting duties and their excellent services are appreciated. Some of the meteorological equipment had not been received or installed yet for this second test, but I am sure that this will be taken care of before any additional tests are completed. The Air Weather Service airplane equipped with radiological instruments once again gave very accurate and worthwhile radiological information. I was sorry to hear that the crew on this airplane is being dispersed, and that there is a possibility that the plane may be deactivated and not made available for this type of operation in the future.
