On the 2nd of May Cmdr Paul Wagner, DMA came in and said that he was desirous of finding out just what we expected of him in regard to the scavenging test. He had evidently expected that we would call him after our meeting of the 25th and give him some specific instructions. I told him that a tentative agreement had been reached - that we would need 200 grams of Pu distributed evenly in 4 Mark 25 spheres for each of 4 shots; in other words, a total of 800 grams. He seemed to consider this reasonable and indicated that as far as he knew this quantity of Pu could be made available. He also said that he would plan on one additional weapon for the biological test. Cmdr Wagner understood perfectly that the figures I ~~xxxx~~ gave him were only a very rough estimate designed as a first approximation for planning purposes. I told him that a more precise answer would be forthcoming on the meeting of the 8th.
