CALIBRATION OF HUMCO II

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I have no objection whatsoever to your proposal for the use of human subjects in your calibration of Humco II. If you have not already done so may I request that you familiarize yourself with the existing rules and regulations regarding the use of humans in such work. The two important points are that (1) the subject should be a bona fide volunteer and fully aware of the nature of the experiment and the dose levels to be used, and (2) the work will be done only under the immediate and personal supervision of a physician who is licensed to practice medicine in New Mexico. With this in mind, there is no reason why you cannot proceed.
