Dear Colonel Thomas:

Here at the Crocker Radiation Laboratory we have been doing some experimental research on the selection of men for certain types of work in the armed forces. We are very anxious to study a large group of young men between the ages of eighteen and twenty-seven.

We have been wondering if it would be possible for us to take a number of normal subjects from the R. O. T. C. In order to do this it will be necessary for the men to sign up to come up to Room 33 Le Conte Hall to spend about one-half hour for the completion of the test. The test will be a very simple one and is something in the nature of a basal metabolism test.

If there is any way that you can suggest that we can contact men in the R. O. T. C. and if you think that it would be possible for us to test this large number of men we would appreciate it very much.
