Dear Dr. Miller:

In confirmation of our telephone conversation yesterday you will shortly be hearing from Dr. Will Siri, one of the senior physicists on our staff. He is fully versed on our mutual objectives and has a copy of your letter of June 2, 1958. When he writes you he will arrange for a mutually convenient time for him to come to Napa. He would like very much to see the facilities that you have arranged for the radio isotope work meanwhile we are going ahead and getting the basic equipment for I-131 uptake measurements. This entails ordering a few of the parts required as we have substantially the equipment needed except for these. There should thereafter be little delay in getting into operation.

I am going on vacation for the next two weeks and if the time arranged by you and Dr. Siri is not until my return I shall probably come down with him.
