Dear Mr. Everson:

For some time we have carried out collaborative work with Dr. von Sallmann of Columbia University, studying the mechanism of induction of cataracts by radiation. Recently it became necessary to consult another ophthalmologist, Prof. Jiro (also known as Samuel) Kimura, who is Asst. Prof. of the University of California Medical School in San Francisco. He has been cleared once by the F.B.I. and went to Hiroshima, commissioned by the National Research Council, to study cataracts induced by the atom bomb there. Would it be possible to make Dr. Kimura consultant to the Donner Laboratory without salary for the purpose of collaboration on our cataract project? I believe the work would involve only restricted or unclassified material, and Dr. Kimura would occasionally visit here in Donner Laboratory or in Bldg. 6, but not in restricted areas.
