

Dear Dobie:

The human subject approval for Dr. Tobias' NCI contract was renewed at the CPHS meeting June 23, 1978. Dr. Tobias is now requesting an addition to protocols 1,2,3 cited above, so that these radiography studies can be done with neon beams. The mammography protocol already includes the use of neon, and it was an oversight that the investigator did not extend the addition of neon to these protocols when they were submitted for renewal in June.

This is now presented as an emergency situation because a patient is coming to have studies done this Thursday, and the neon beam may be the only one available. The available members of the Human Use Committee were contacted and agreed that this was an appropriate use of neon. We therefore request an interim approval for the use of neon in these protocols, pending review at your meeting August 3.
