Dear Dr. Heller:

I am pleased to inform you that Atomic Energy Commission contribution toward support of your project, "Effects of Ionizing Radiation on the Testicular Function of Man," has been approved but at less than the requested level. The Research Committee made the following recommendations:

1. That any request for irradiation of additional human subjects beyond this contract year not be approved.
2. That a significant reduction in the funding level be made beginning next year and reduced each subsequent year in anticipation of a sequential reduction in research effort and requirements as the objectives are achieved.

The negotiation of the contract, including financial detail, will be handled by our Richland Operations Office, and you may expect to hear from a representative of that office shortly. Responsibility for the technical and scientific administration will, of course, remain with the Division of Biology and Medicine in Washington.
