SUBJECT: WORK ITEMS

I am working on three (3) major items:

1. Generally licensed quantities.
2. Basic criteria for consumer products including individual items and a national capacity from the standpoint of individual exposure and contamination of the environs.
3. The generally licensing of medical use of radioisotopes. This would first be accomplished by general licensing of diagnostic uses. After a period of a few months experience I believe we could license all routine uses. This would be accomplished by publishing in the Federal Register minimum training and experience under a licensee or an approved course and minimum facilities and equipment. Perhaps registration is all that would be needed. All generally licensees would then be required to register with us at the time they made application for radioisotopes.

All of these items require considerable thought but I feel that we have enough know how to develop the necessary frame work <sup>to</sup> ~~executing~~ these simplifications.

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
