Your research project which was submitted to the Commission's Division of Biology and Medicine, Washington, D. C., has been approved by that office in the amount of \$10,000.00 and has been forwarded to this office for preparation of an appropriate contract covering the Commission's support of your project.

Enclosed in triplicate, is a contract numbered as shown in the subject line above which incorporates in Appendix "A" a description of your project and the budget for the first period which you are to follow as a general guide.
