Gentlemen:

Enclosed, in four copies, is Modification No. 1 to the contract numbered as shown in the subject line above, which incorporates in a revision to Appendix "A" the program and budget for the year beginning July 1, 1950 and ending June 30, 1951.

Your attention is invited to the provisions of Article III, sections 1 and 2. You will note that the contract has been converted from a cost type to a lump sum type for the entire period of the contract and the amount previously paid to you on cost vouchers is now stated to represent the initial payment of the lump sum consideration. The revised contract amount has taken into consideration the unexpended balance of funds, if any, previously obligated under the contract as reflected in the recent report submitted by you.

Your attention is also invited to the provisions of Article VI, wherein you are granted title to all property previously transferred to the Commission from the Navy. Also note that a new Section 18 has been added to Appendix "B" concerning fellowships.

This modification has been signed by the Commission's Contracting Officer and will become effective upon your execution. If the modification, as written, is satisfactory to you it is requested that the appropriate Budget Manager and the proper official of the College sign in the space provided on page 4 and return the original and one signed copy to this office. The fee remaining unexpended is retained for your use. It is extremely important that this modification be signed by you prior to June 30, 1950.

Gentlemen:

Please refer to your letter of May 6, 1950, in which you furnished information concerning certain expenditures submitted to the General Contract No. 49-10-1-000. These expenditures were questioned by the General Accounting Office in an Internal Inquiry, No. A-415-0(1), for the reason that they appear to fall in the category of overhead costs which are not reimbursable under the contract.

Except for Item 3, the explanations which you have furnished on each of the questioned transactions have been accepted as being adequate in establishing that these are direct purchases made necessary by reason of the scientific work required to be done under the contract. We are, accordingly, making reply to the inquiry on that basis.

Item 3 covers a purchase of venetian blinds in the amount of \$27.00. It is our opinion that this is correctly an item of overhead, since the equipping of a laboratory with venetian blinds is not the type of cost that may be considered as being necessary for the furtherance of the scientific work under the contract.

In view of the above, credit for the amount in question, \$27.00, should be allowed us on your next voucher submitted for reimbursement.

Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your letter under date of May 25, 1950 and enclosure relative to reply to the General Accounting Office's Informal Inquiry No. A-425-C (1).

The last paragraph of the reply to the above General Accounting Office's inquiry is as follows:

"Item (3) in the inquiry covers a charge of \$20.00 for cost of venetian blinds. The contractor has been advised that this cost is not considered reimbursable under the contract and that credit should be allowed the government under the next voucher submitted for reimbursement."

According to the records in this office, we have not received the above advice relative to the venetian blinds cost. Shall we expect to receive formal advice from you to this effect?


The present term of your research program under subject contract will expire on June 30, 1950.

Our research grant (Contract No. 63700) for work with the Atomic Energy Commission, which was administered by the Department of Navy, Office of the Naval Research were for the year ended June 30, 1949. Our contract for this research activity for the year ending June 30, 1950 is being handled directly by the Atomic Energy Commission at Oak Ridge, Tennessee. Attached is a draft of a research contract which has been negotiated with the Norman Gray School of Medicine of Wake Forest College. It is requested that you prepare this contract in final form for execution. In preparing this contract it is requested that you include the new clause which you have recently developed covering security clearance procedures.

Since the contracts have been negotiated to permit the description of projects in Appendix "A" under separate titles, Article V, Section 2, in the basic contract form has been revised to provide that the period of reports will be that set forth in Appendix "A". This was necessary since the Washington Division approving the projects is in some cases specifying reporting periods different from the standard quarterly reports required by Article V.

The Record of negotiation will be furnished to you as soon as possible. I hope that you will be able to proceed with the contract preparation before you receive the record of negotiation since time is running short: he sees now and June 30, the end of the fiscal year.
