Thank you for referring to this office for review a document entitled "Blood Changes in Humans Following Total Body Irradiation" by J. J. Nickson. It is conceivable that if it became a matter of common knowledge that experiments on human beings such as those described in this document were being carried on by the Commission it might result in some adverse publicity and perhaps encourage litigation. However, we feel that this objection is outweighed by the advantages to be gained by making this information available to technically trained personnel.
