Included herewith is self-explanatory telegram to me from the NRDL at San Francisco.

The matter of the availability of fuel for the Navy courier plane employed in connection with Civil Effects tests experiments has been discussed with Colonel Fackler and he reassured me of the availability of fuel at Indian Springs. The exact conditions which prevailed on May 8th, as referred to in the telegram, are not known to me.

The remarks relative to the "overlong exposures of animals to low temperatures" incurred as a result of the mix-up on re-fueling, could, in my opinion, jeopardize the success of the experiments involved, and I would like for you to let me know if this is the case in the incident in question.
