I presume that complete nuclear chemical and physical analyses are being made of the material resulting from the New Mexico explosion if it was possible to recover anything containing an appreciable amount of radioactive substances.

We are particularly interested in the heavy isotope content of such material and would like to analyze a sample if you did recover something and have some to spare.

I will be away from Chicago for a couple of weeks but Perlman or Manning could arrange for the handling of the material at Chicago.

Perhaps it will be worthwhile later to study some of the Japanese homeland from the neighborhood of Hiroshima or Nagasaki.
