Minutes of the Tech Board Meeting

1. Dr. Bradbury discussed Laboratory Philosophy and the reaction following the Interim Council discussion last Monday. Graves (representing "M" Division in the absence of Froman), presented parts of a paper drafted presenting position of Morrison, Spence, Manley and others based on premise that research and production don't mix. Copies of the Morrison committee paper are to be distributed for further study.

2. Dr. Bradbury discussed a petition he had received which recommended that construction of the new houses be stopped and the plans be revised.

3. The Declassification Group under Delhoffman, since it represents personally, will not, for the time being, be included in the proposed division under Smith.

4. Dr. Manley discussed the Declassification setup and the matter of accomplishing revisions to the Tolman Committee Guide by means of the Committee of Responsible Reviewers.

5. Dr. Bradbury mentioned the tentative recreation plans for the scientific conference and the impossibility of using Government funds for entertainment. It is proposed that there be planned a picnic one evening and a cocktail party another, to which all members of the Interim Council be invited, members of the council sharing the expense. Mr. Acher of the Lodge would cater. Approval of the Interim Council will be sought next Monday.

6. Colonel Soeman discussed questions asked at the last meeting on the subject of emergency passes.

a. It is Major Newburger's desire to post names of responsible individuals on every building and not just special buildings.

b. There is no security guard on every special building and when there is one, he does not have orders which include notification to responsible technical personnel in case of emergency.

c. Maj. Newburger states the Fire Department has no SOP for calling responsible technical personnel on fire calls received from special buildings. (Dr. Jette believes this in error since his division has given to Mr. Wagner a list of people to be called in emergency.

d. The emergency passes being revised do include an all area class. A very limited quantity for such individuals as Bradbury, Seeman, Newburger, etc. Emergency passes do not permit holder to admit an assistant, consequently division leaders were advised to include in their recommendations for emergency passes, more group leaders and other responsible persons than originally considered in holding the list to a minimum.

7. Colonel Seeman discussed the under-classification of the minutes of the 18 July meeting and advised that recipients would be contacted and changes made.
